We are in receipt of your letter, dated Nov. 17th, 1925.
We are very pleased to know that our Station has been heard, by several of your fans.

Our call letters, as assigned by the Government, are S Q E, but they are only used in our short wave experimental telegraph station: when broadcasting we do not use them, but you will frequently hear the announcement: "Radio Sociedade do Rio de Janeiro".

Our wavelength is 401 mts. and our programs are broadcast at the following hours, at noon, 17, and 20 o'clock, local time our programs are made up as far as possible of instructional material, lightly intermingled with music.

Our station is a master oscillator circuit using a 1.500 watts on the power amplifier and its maker is the Marconi Co
